KMC renovates the old Kamativi bus termini

KMC hosts the Chingahali Mountain Festival to honour traditional customs

Kamativi Mining Company (KMC) hosted a traditional ritual to respect, honour and appease ancestral spirits of the local Tonga people.

The Chingahali Mountain Festival was led by local chiefs and traditional leaders from the greater Kamativi area namely Chief Nekatambe, Chief Pashu, among others.

The purpose of the Chingahali Mountain Festival was aimed to demonstrate KMC's respect and appreciation of local traditional culture and customs; honour traditional leaders; respect the ancestors of the land; inculcate seamless cultural integration between the Chinese and the local Tonga people; promote sustainable natural resources extraction and development of mining communities.

Traditional leaders believe traditional rituals such as the Chingahali Mountain Festival enhance easy location of the mineral belt, prevent unnecessary mine accidents and promote smooth mining and processing operations.

KMC noted that in order to effectively integrate into Zimbabwean culture, understanding and respecting local customs and traditions; actively participating in community events, and building relationships with local communities were key deliverables for sustainable development.

This is not the first time a traditional ritual like the Chingahali Mountain Festival has been held.

In most parts of the world, each area has its own local tradition to follow.

Local elders believe traditional rituals must be held to prevent inexplicable happenings during mining operations. **ENDS//**

KMC refurbishes the Kamativi community hall



On Wednesday 31st July 2024, Kamativi Mining Company (KMC) hosted a handover ceremony of the recently renovated Kamativi Community Auditorium, adding new contributions towards development of the Kamativi community infrastructure.

The community auditorium had been abandoned for years following the closure of Kamativi Tin Mines (KTM) leading to the roof collapsing, making it inhabitable and inaccessible to host events.

The event was attended by scores of people including KMC General Manager Mr. Ye Jianguo, local government representatives, local chiefs, community leaders, village representatives and community members.

To enhance the cohesion and sense of belonging of the community, KMC made a good investment of manpower and resources. The restoration of the Kamativi auditorium to its former glory was spearheaded Mr Wei Xu, Head of the Mining Construction department. New windows and doors were installed while ablution facilities were spruced

up, with the overall infrastructure topped up with a fresh coat of paint. The auditorium resumes as an important place for community gatherings.

During the handover ceremony, Jianguo gave a keynote speech emphasizing the need to assimilate KMC's developmental values into the Kamativi community.

"KMC always insists on closely integrating the development of enterprises with the prosperity of the community, and strives to create a better living environment for the community. We believe that enterprises are not only the promoters of economic growth, but also the practitioners of social responsibility.
